Introduction

Jesus is Coming Back Very Soon!

There are several fundamental essentials to being “Christian.” Among the essential core tenants are; belief in **“the One True God”**, belief in the **“Bible as the Word of God to mankind”** and belief and faith in **“Jesus Christ as our personal redeeming Savior sent by God”**. These, among other foundational tenants should lead each of us to ponder the question; **“Am I a Christian?”** Based on the Bible, am I really? How do I know for sure? More importantly; **“How can I be sure that I am?”**

Being Christian in America (*roughly 75% claim to be*) is becoming less popular. Approximately 90% of all American homes claim to have a Bible yet only 11% claim to have read the Bible cover to cover. Only, 53% have ever read more than a few passages of the Bible.

This begs the question; if we are not actually reading the Bible, how do we know we actually are Christian? **What is the Biblical requirement?**

It is apparent that if we are not regularly reading the Bible, there must be some other basis that causes people to believe that they are “a Christian.” Is church attendance, or just believing in “a” god, the validation that we “meet God’s requirements?” Could your or my own beliefs be in contradiction with actual “Biblical requirements?”

According to the Bible, believing in “a” god, or even believing in the **“One True God” does not make a person a Christian.** **Jam 2:19 You believe that God is one. You do well; the demons also believe and shudder.** Neither does the Bible teach us that merely attending church makes one a Christian. And it seems reasonable, that if the One True God provided directions on how to get into Heaven and what it means to be Christian, **shouldn't we be serious about reading His actual**

instructions? The fact is, **as God, His criteria, not ours** will decide who is going to reside eternally with Him in Heaven and who will be cast eternally into Hell. Thus, we “as Christians” should be structuring our lives solidly on the instructions God provided.

In many countries, being a Biblical Christian is illegal. Many of our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ are being killed, beaten or locked up just for identifying as Christian. Clearly, their faith and belief are solid!

So, the question to you and I is; if we were to be arrested today and hauled into court and charged for the crime of being a “Christian”, would we still profess that we are? Would our admission and knowledge of Christian doctrine be so solid within our heart that we would willingly subject ourself to cruel punishment or death? Or would a judge rule that we don’t know enough about God’s word and there’s little evidence that we actually demonstrated our Christian faith in daily life. Would there be enough evidence in our life to convict us?

I’m not trying to change or build any sort of doctrinal stance with what follows in this series, yet I do understand that some; Christians, pastors or theologians may have stances of their own that they have taught (*likely around the aspects of the length of creation, when it took place, aspects of the rapture and perhaps other teachings*) that may be challenged by what I will be sharing in this series.

Please understand I desire no conflict and I’m quite comfortable waiting for God to show all of us how the future will actually unfold. While the Word of God takes aim at the heart of man (**Jer 17:9**), I know there are many pastors and brothers and sisters in Christ who are of a virtuous heart, who sincerely want to please God. We can and will love each other as brothers/sisters in Christ, even if we disagree about something.

We all agree: in any tug of war regarding what your or my views, beliefs or ideas are ... God and the scriptures must reign supreme, for the fallible shall not rise above the that which is not. **2 Tim 3:16-17** [All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;](#) ¹⁷ so that the man of God may be adequate, [equipped for every good work.](#) **Isaiah 44:6-8** *“Thus says the Lord, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the Lord of hosts: ‘I am the first and I am the last and there is **no God besides Me.**’ ⁷ ‘Who is like Me? Let him proclaim and declare it; yes, let him recount it to Me in order, from the time that I established the ancient nation. And let*

them declare to them the things that are coming and the events that are going to take place. ⁸ ‘Do not tremble and do not be afraid; Have I not long since announced it to you and declared it?’ And you are My witnesses. Is there any God besides Me, or is there any *other* Rock? I know of none.’”

God and God’s Word shall be and must be honored by all of us who by comparison are feeble in every way. **Isaiah 30:8** Now go, write it on a tablet before them and inscribe it on a scroll, that it may serve in the time to come as a witness forever. **2 Pet 1:19-21** So we have the prophetic word made more sure, to which you do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your hearts. ²⁰ But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one’s own interpretation, ²¹ for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

Straight up, my interpretations of God’s Word are indeed fallible and I could be in error. Throughout the world we have many Christian denominations because of disagreements about Biblical interpretation. Indeed, I have had to leave a couple of churches because of serious “scriptural error” in what was taught. God bless our pastors. Being a pastor, a pastor’s wife or child is no cake walk. Pray for your pastors!

It is quite common to debate and reason from the Bible and to make allowances for minor disagreements. I love that God made us all different! Each part of the body, has a purpose. **(1 Cor 12:12-26)** Yet some ministers teach “as if it was doctrine” (*an essential belief*), a pre-tribulation rapture. The timing of the rapture is NOT doctrine. When I read the Bible, I find that there is a full plate of ambiguity within the Scriptures that makes such a rigid stance absurd. The timing of the rapture is not definitive nor conclusive; there is some vagueness about “the when”. My heart goes out to all the pastors who “*very likely(?)*” in a few short years have to explain to their flock why their other teachings should be trusted “*if*” their congregation goes thru the various unpleasant aspects of the Tribulation. Then their members will ask; “*what else has our pastor been wrong about?*”

There are many amazing things that occur in the Bible, things beyond our modern comprehension, but I don’t doubt for a second any of God’s Word; not the flood, not the tower of Babel, not that people lived hundreds of years, not the virgin birth: for me ... **it’s all true.**

And I understand that we only have a tiny fraction of what God did in the past, a smidgin of God's history and power. Yet, God is not done, He has much more in store. **Isaiah 65:17-18** “For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; and the former things will not be remembered or come to mind.”¹⁸ “But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create ...

I am convinced that the 40 days Jesus spent with His disciples after Jesus's resurrection, had to be the most incredible knowledge dump in the history of mankind. Imagine the miracle working man, the Son of God, whom taught you over the prior 3 years, who was killed and hung on a cross, then buried in a cave ... but then He comes back to life! WOW! Jesus then spends the next 6 weeks telling you about many wonderful things of God and His Kingdom before He departs back to Heaven. These once timid and unassuming men ... now get it!

Jesus summarizes what really matters. **Mark 12:28-31** One of the scribes came and heard them arguing and recognizing that He {Jesus} had answered them well, asked Him, “What commandment is the foremost of all?” Jesus answered, “The foremost is, ‘Hear, O Israel! **The Lord our God is one Lord; and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.**’ “The second is this, ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no other commandment greater than these.”

The Bible is our source for drawing near to God

Before becoming a Believer, I bought a Bible to explore. Initially, reading the Bible cover to cover was hard to digest. The 1st translation I read was a King James Version (KJV), which uses Old English language making it hard for me to understand. I then began using the New International Version (NIV), before settling on the New American Standard Bible (NASB). I think the English Standard Version (ESV) is a good translation as well.

Yet, like many Christians for much of my past my Bible sat on a shelf. After I started going to church, I often brought my Bible with me, but I rarely read it on my own. All that changed. These days, I keep it near me and try to read it every day. The Bible is a smorgasbord feast; I can't stop reading it.

To be sure, our Bible is filled with scriptures recounting the past, but it is also where God reveals what will occur in the future. God reveals the

future on purpose to prove that He is the One and Only God. God wants us to trust Him and proves He can be trusted. The Bible is designed to bring people who want to know the One True God into a closer relationship with Him. What follows in this tract, is just some of the many things I've found in my Bible reading journey.

When we learn to open our mind to view time with a much larger view than just a few months or a couple of years, we gain a perspective that was in plain sight, yet escaped our notice. **Prov 3:5-6** Trust in the Lord with all your heart and **do not lean on your own understanding**. ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge Him and **He will make your paths straight**. We naturally think in our own way, but God's ways are way above our own. Thus, we have to make adjustments in our thought pattern, to open our mind to what God is telling us. If we only focus on our life now in the day we live, the striving for things and trying to get ahead, we will miss God's best for us. **Rom 12:2** And **do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind**, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

The Lord will guide us if we ask Him too. **Luke 24:45-47** Then **He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures**, ⁴⁶ and He said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead the third day," ⁴⁷ and that repentance for forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. The final few years of life as we know it is about to come to an end; there will be increasing instability as we move forward to its end. Think about this, **it is literally about to happen!**

For Believers, God is not only God our Creator, He is our Father. There is much our Father will do and provide for in our next life, thousands of times more wonderful and marvelous than this life. But there also awaits a Great Judgement for all those who blew off God. For those who ignore God, they will be exiled to a place called Hell, absent the God they rejected.

The only preparation you or I need is to get in right relationship with God, we do that by repenting of our sins, confessing our sins to God, to believe and trust God and His Son to do what they said they will do, "to save us". **1 John 5:11-12** And the testimony is this, **that God has given us eternal life and this life is in His Son**. ¹² **He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life.**

Summary of This Booklet

Our Bible reveals Jesus will return again (*often referred to as “the 2nd coming of Christ”*) *sometime between the start of 2030 ... and the end of 2036 (*most likely based upon the Hebrew calendar*) and this time Jesus returns as conquering King! (**My opinion reading the Scriptures*)

The road to understanding a “God Day” was a journey, yet solidly confirmed in the Word. **Deut 19:15 ... on the evidence of two or three witnesses a matter shall be confirmed.** Some of us have an understanding regarding “*the law of 3 mentions*” when it comes to Biblical interpretation and an awareness of how cults have built doctrine upon a single verse taken out of context. I felt if God wants to clearly let us know that He is using a pattern of 1,000 yearlong days in a 7-day week that is capped by a Sabbath day of rest, He will confirm it so there is no doubt.

When I first understood this “God Day” concept, I was hesitant, but it seemed the Good Lord was confirming to me that this was something He wanted me to know and to share with others. Hence, I am writing this series to hopefully explain it in a manner that would allow you to embrace what I believe God is showing us at this very late hour. Let me define a “God Day”.

God Day? –*a period of 1,000 Gregorian calendar years.*

“Thousand” is used 135x in the OT and NT, often following a greater value than one thousand. The term “God Day” occurs nowhere in the Bible, rather it is my attempt to uniquely identify a 1,000 years long day not to be confused with a 24-hour day. **2 Peter 3:8** But do not let this one fact escape your notice, beloved, that with the Lord one {God} day is like a thousand years and a thousand years {of mankind} like one {God} day. Peter clearly articulates the way he (*and now I*) describes how God views a day, i.e. a “God Day”. This term is currently not used or acknowledged in any circle of modern Christianity that I know of.

While the use of the word “day” in the Bible can and often does mean a 24-hour day as we know it, there are at least 4 instances when it appears to mean a 1,000 year long “God Day”. Three verses of the same subject matter, meet the definition of “the law of 3 mentions.” Thus, clearly establishing 1000 yrs as one way God views a day.

Jesus is Coming Back Very Soon!

*From my heart to yours; If you are reading this, you and I were chosen by God to be in this very generation that sees the return of His Son. **Matt 24:34** I view this as a great honor yet with great responsibility. It is not going to be a time without suffering; we must understand that suffering is key to getting rid of all that is unbecoming of the children of God. If you agree with the premise of this tract, it's time to ask God to cleanse you from all sin, to serve Him with your gifts in these last days, to love and worship the Lord your God with your whole heart and to love our fellow man. I've not been the best example, but I asked God to cleanse me and He did. My mind use to be filled with worldly things, now I desire to serve and please God. We will still be trapped in this body of flesh, but our hearts will be aligned with God. Expect rough waters ahead, but retain your joy, for very soon **we will enter His rest**. Before it's too late, you and I need to reach out to many others and introduce them to God's Son, our Redeemer. We are the servants (slaves) of the King in **Matt 22:1-10** we are ordered to gather in **all** who will come. Our task is just to give the invitation that we once accepted. I'm praying for you even without knowing you, I believe God will use you and I in this final last push to reach all who are willing. ([[bro hugs]])*

The Burden is On Me to Make the Case for God Days and the Expected Return of the Lord, Let's Begin!

To make for easier comprehension, I outline Jesus expected return between 2030 to 2036 in 8 steps. **You decide** if you find each step plausible? If you do not, then you'll likely not agree with the premise. If you are unfamiliar with Biblical concepts, you will have trouble understanding what is written here. No worries, start diving into your Bible, get familiar, then come back and reread this. My main message is not much different from Biblical text, **the soon coming of the Messiah**, God's anointed Son, yet with a greater urgency to get in right relationship with God. It's quite literally about to happen.* Christ's long awaited return and Great Judgment are very, very near. (*With a 25% chance that I'm altogether wrong!)

1. **Consider this** – **God's calendar and mankind's are different**; thus, when it comes to discerning the end times, we may have to learn to think using God's calendar, not so much our current Gregorian calendar. God's character is unchanging, but He interacts with mankind as He desires and He does make changes. When we read something that does not align with our modern way of thought, we tend to read over it and set it aside.



Example: **2 Pet 3:8** But **do not overlook this one fact**, beloved, that **with the Lord one day is as a thousand years and a thousand years as one day**. It makes me laugh, I did the exact opposite of what Peter wrote, I “overlooked” this EVERY TIME I read it!

This fact is also reflected in **Psalm 90:4**, For **a thousand years in your {God} sight, are but as yesterday when it is past...** We now have 2 scriptures espousing a 1,000 year long “God Day”, two witness is enough to stand on, but let’s see if we can find a 3rd

Bible based witness that would absolutely solidify a point God appears to be making. **2 Pet 3:8, Ps 90:4, (Gen 2:16-17+ Gen 5:5)**

The Bible is telling us that 1,000 years is one day in God’s eyes.

2. **Consider this** – The Hebrew word for “day” has **28** separate meanings (*the most for any single word I ever recall researching*) and often these mean something other than a 24-hour day, up to and including; an indefinite period of time, a limited amount of time or long period. (*Dictionary of Biblical Languages Hebrew Old Testament, James Swanson 2nd edition 2001*)

Yet when you and I read the Bible, we think only in terms of what we understand something to be in this day we live and thus we think of a “day” only as a 24-hour period. This can cause us to miss a better understanding of what God is trying to convey to us. Defining terms is extremely important. But most important is what the Bible says about how God views a day. I may devote a booklet solely to definitions at some point in the future.

Thus, a day can mean something much longer than a 24-hour day.

3. **Consider this** – The word “day,” appears 2,342x in the Bible. “*In that day*” 92x and “*on that day*” 75x in the NASB Bible. When I read the Bible, sometimes I’m not fully paying attention, ☹ some verses just roll by in my mind, the following verse use to be one of them. But now with the understanding of how God can be using the word “day”, it becomes much more vivid. God warned Adam; **Gen 2:17 ... but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.** It’s true, thru Adam’s disobedience, sin and death entered the

world. **Rom 5:12-19**. Yet, Adam ate of the tree and lived on to be 930 yrs old (**Gen 5:5**). Did God lie? Of course not! I've never kept track of how many times I've read thru the Bible and specifically the book of Genesis, but this most recent time I read it, verse 17 stood out **"you" shall surely die.**

What was I thinking when I read this all the times before? I could only conclude that I and perhaps everyone else who read this scripture took **"in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die"**, to be "metaphoric", we never considered Adam actually died "in the day", because Adam didn't die in the 24hr day he and Eve ate its fruit. But Adam in fact lived hundreds of years beyond the 24 hour day when he ate the fruit. However, with this new understanding we now know factually Adam died in the "God Day" (1,000 Gregorian years long "God Day") that he ate of the forbidden fruit. This is indeed a solid 3rd Bible reference confirming how God views a day, in His eyes, it's a 1,000 year long, day.

For me, the 1,000 yearlong "God Day" is solidly established.

4. **Consider this** – God established a pattern for days that make up a week, 6-work days in a row, which is capped by a day of rest. **Exodus 20:8-11** **"Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates. For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea and all that is in them and rested on the seventh day. Therefore, the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.**

God is telling us, that 6-days are for working and toil, the 7th day is a complete day of rest to Him. We have this 7-day pattern that **always finishes** with a Sabbath day of rest.

The implication of course is that mankind here on earth will toil and work for 6 thousand years (6-God Days), but then on the Sabbath day, the 7th God Day, we are to rest. This Sabbath day of rest will be 1,000 years long. This is solidly based upon the very Word of God. Ex 16:25-30, 23:10-12, 31:15-17, Lev 23:3

A 7-day week consists of 6 days of work followed by the Sabbath day of rest.

5. **Consider this** – The Bible tells us that in front of us is a 1,000 year long “day of rest” period in which those martyred because of their faithful devotion to God and His Son and those who do not worship the beast nor received the mark of the beast in the Great Tribulation (**Rev 20:4**) will be resurrected before everyone else and they will reign on earth with Jesus Christ for that entire 1,000 years long Sabbath God Day of rest. Satan is locked up during this 1,000 years long period. **Rev 20:1-6** Theologians call this the “Millenium”. With my new understanding of a “God Day” and the 7-day week pattern God put in place, I believe the Millenium is clearly the 7th day (*Sabbath*) of rest. The Millenium is a Sabbath “God Day”.

Entering the Sabbath rest is confirmed for Believers in the NT and excluded for those who are not Believers. **Heb 4:5-10 ... and again in this passage, “They shall not enter My rest.”** ⁶ Therefore, since it remains for some to enter it and those who formerly had good news preached to them failed to enter because of disobedience, ⁷ He again fixes a certain day, “Today,” saying through David after so long a time just as has been said before, “Today if you hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts.” ⁸ For if Joshua had given them rest, He would not have spoken of another day after that. ⁹ So there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God. ¹⁰ For the one who has entered His rest has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His.

Clearly the Bible is telling us this 6,000 years of this age will culminate in a Sabbath day of rest. *Rev 20:2, 20:4, 20:6*

The 1,000 year period we call the Millenium is the Sabbath day of rest.

Jesus is Coming Back Very Soon!

closely at the last graphic, you'd say: "Hey, we are past the Gregorian calendar year of the year 2000AD, its 2025!" We would already be in the 7-day, the Sabbath day of rest, which theologians refer to as the Millennium **Rev 20:1-7**, which is the 1,000 reign of Christ on earth. *Great point grasshopper!* **We clearly are not in the Sabbath Day of rest.**

This Biblically defined pattern would appear to be falling apart ... but we must consider that God is not bound by mankind's Gregorian calendar. Dugh! In fact, God does not use our current Gregorian calendar, if He did, He'd have to set aside the one He told the Hebrew people to follow.

God initiated a different calendar of months for the Hebrew people.

Exodus 12:1-2 Now the Lord said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, ² **"This month shall be the beginning of months for you; it is to be the first month of the year to you.** The Hebrew first month is known as Aviv or Nisan and occurs in our Gregorian calendar months of March and April. Not only that, the Bible refers to a 24-hour day as "from sunset to the following sunset", i.e., night begins the day, it is not broken at 12 midnight like we use today. **Lev 23:32**

POINT: God is not using our Gregorian calendar, nor our idea of midnight splitting days. Our Creator uses His own method for counting time.

Mankind's history of calendars is fascinating, **but it's a history of utter mishmash**. Since ancient times there have been many, many calendars in use. Some cultures kept track of time by the name of a king and the year in which he reigned. Our Gregorian calendar wasn't adopted until the 16th century ad. It wasn't internationally adopted until 1988. Early calendars contained time keeping errors and were not often in sync to other tribal calendars. There are still about a dozen other calendars in use around the world today. The use of "bc" and "ad" also evolved over time. The fact is, mankind has no idea when the first year was. So today, we count backward and forward from a Gregorian calendar 1bc/1ad division point that was supposed to represent Jesus's birth. Modern theologians say Jesus was actually born several years earlier. With this perspective, the year 2025 is; *"just a point in time from a manmade reference point"*. As humans we have a somewhat limited knowledge of history, wrought with a mishmash of event date guesses. Thus, it would be fruitless to try to establish the "actual year of creation" for mankind using our Gregorian calendar.

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POINT: Historical events (Biblical or otherwise) with respect to our Gregorian calendar always have various degrees of uncertainty attached to them and we have no link to when 1,000 years long God Days start or stop within our Gregorian calendar.

POINT: A “God Day” does not start or stop on our Gregorian calendar dates of 1bc or 1ad, with 1,000 increments on either side.

With respect to Biblical prophecy, we do need understand how or when God’s calendar and our Gregorian calendar can be synchronized or laid over one to the other. It is apparent there is an alignment offset, but how much of an offset?

What do we have to work with? God did provide us a “summary” of the creation period events where He outlined what He did on each day. God was the first person to divide periods of time into days and then to describe distinct activity that He did in each day. Thus, with God, days have distinctions of different tasks on different days. An interesting phrase occurs several times. **Gen 1:5,8,13,19,23,31** And there was evening and there was morning, one day. This particular phrase only occurs in the 6-work days of creation. The length of each day appears to be 24hrs, related to the terms evening and morning, the time for our earth to make one complete revolution.

What we do not know is; has the earth rotated at its current speed since the beginning? There is no evidence to suggest otherwise, however, God is fully capable of changing any aspect of our solar system and God has done this in the past. Read; **2 Kings 20:9-11, Amos 8:9, Joshua 10:12-14.** The 6-day creation event appears to be the 24-hour day He wanted us to understand, but I’ll leave room that it may not have been that way originally. We know God makes small and big adjustments anytime He feels like it. God initially had man living nearly 1,000 years, then He cut it back to 120, then He again cut it back to 70—80 years. God can also start over too anytime He desires. God created man, but then was sorry He did (**Gen 6:6-7**) and wiped out all of mankind other than a very few with Noah.

God doesn’t seek to trick us, but we have to understand what God says through those who He or Christ spoke thru. We also have to yield to the fact, God is God, He gets to do anything He wants! But we are blessed in that God loves us, He wants a relationship with wants us and us to know Him and love Him as a “Father.”

POINT: Time is whatever God wants it to be, He is not bound by the system He created, rather He is the Master of time and creation.

Not giving up, I went on a long (*months*) period of focusing on Biblical history. While researching certain major Biblical events I also learned that they too can be a mishmash of dates depending upon who is setting the dates. Nothing says God has to do anything significant to move from one 1,000 year long day to the next, but He might. So, I went looking for synergy in that regard.

7. **Consider this – We need to sync our Gregorian calendar to God’s calendar to know where we are at.** The closest major Biblical events we have are centered around the time of Christ and even those dates have some uncertainty. Many historical theologians say Jesus was born apx. 3-4 bc. The Bible indicates Jesus lived to be 33-36 yrs old (**Luke 3:23** *about 30 + apx 3-4 yrs of ministry, but a few theologians think He was significantly older*) and while Jesus’s birth is a great day, **the day of His resurrection was an even better day, because on that day, Jesus proved He was Lord over sin and death.** Jesus had prior proved He was Lord over death by resurrecting people from the dead. Taken together, Jesus has the power and authority to resurrect us as well. Many theologians cite 33ad as the year for His death and resurrection; I have to concur by default.

Jesus usured in a **New Covenant**, one based on faith and grace. The physical manmade Temple was destroyed (70ad) and Believers now receive the Holy Spirit within our hearts, rather than the Holy Spirit coming into the Temple and just to the high Priest. God is now with us via the indwelling of His Holy Spirit. **Heb 8:8, 8:13, 9:15, 10:20, 12:24**

Jesus’s resurrection was a pivotal landmark between the Old and New Covenants. It could be a good division point to work from.

At this point I believe the year of Jesus’s death and resurrection in 33ad (*+/-3 yrs of speculation*) creates a distinction that separates one God Day from the next, but I’d like more support for it. If its valid, I reason that there should be other significant events that also took place on (*or near, due to the error in historical dating*) the dividing point of other God Days, thus supporting 33ad as a dividing point from one God Day to the next. If so, I should find other significant events occurring at other 1,000 yr long God Day division

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points in our Gregorian calendar, bolstering the support for 33ad^{+/-} as “dividing date” between two God Days.

What I found is there are several historical events (bc and ad) that support 1,000 years long division points before and after 33ad. (*one God Day to the next God Day*) These events lend credibility to not only 33ad as a division point, but also to the overall 7-God Days “age”. All of which in my mind would solidify **Jesus Christ’s resurrection as beginning a new day, specifically the beginning of the 5th God Day**. Yet, we have to consider, the further we go back in time, the more speculative event timing becomes.

Thus, my basis for 33ad being the start of the 5th day of course begins with this: **Jesus’s resurrection certainly ushered in the “new Covenant of Grace.”** Separating the “*Old Covenant of Law*” from the “*New Covenant of Grace thru Faith*” by a break between days would certainly be reasonable, because a new day dawned for mankind.

So, I began looking backward in time for a repeating pattern that would support 33ad as being a division point, i.e., the beginning of a new God Day. I then plotted each God Day division point. Using 1,000 year increments the dates become; “3967bc, 2967bc, 1967bc, 967bc, **33ad, 1033ad**” and “**2033ad**” which is just in front of us. I’ll begin working backward from 2033ad to keep the time flow constant.

- a) < Future> **2033ad, is the year (^{+/-}3 yrs) we might expect Jesus Christ to return.** If this hypothesis holds water, we can expect that prophetic events have to begin occurring just as Jesus and the prophets said they would. I believe Jesus Christ’s return is indeed almost upon us. I’ve shaded this bullet because it’s just a theory that yet needs to be confirmed. The year 2033, would mark the end of God Day 6, the start of God Day 7, the Sabbath day of rest.
- b) **Synergy with the Jordan Rift event in 1033ad.** This was a devastating earthquake along the Jordan Valley. The event and timeline are reviewed in a research paper called; “*The Kinematics of the 1033ad Earthquake Revealed by the Damage at Hisham Palace*” (I found on this website www.academia.edu) Almost as if to serve as a reminder to the peoples of the world that Jesus, God’s Son, was crucified and resurrected 1,000 yrs earlier in this very region. A magnitude 9-10 earthquake. Coincidence? Or the One True God showing that all who oppose God have something to

fear? (Don't agonize about the people who died in this quake. God does nothing that is not just. Those who died either were enemies of God, or those whom God will grant mercy to in the next life. Death happens to us all, some by a slow cancer, others by violence, yet most by old age. And all who have died will be resurrected. Some to face God's wrath, others welcomed into His joy.)
1033ad, would mark the end of God Day 5 the start of God Day 6

- c) **33ad the year (+/-3 yrs) Jesus was hung on a cross, died and 3-days later rose from the dead.** This is also shaded this text because it is the basis for my theory that Jesus's resurrection provided a logical division point between one God Day and the next.
33ad, would mark the end of God Day 4, the start of God Day 5.
- d) **967bc has synergy with the building of the 1st Temple and God coming down to mankind.** (33ad – 1000= 967bc) Solomon's Temple was started &/or completed (*depending upon the speculative historical date*) and dedicated (*God fills the temple*) within a small time period that several sources identify as "967bc", which if accurate would equate as the 3rd to 4th day transition and exactly 1 "God Day" before Christ's 33ad resurrection. Cite; **1)** "Archaeology's Lost Conquest" www.answeresingenesis.org, **2)** "Solomon's Temple" www.esv.org. Other web sources suggest other dates. Solomon, the son of David, began building the Temple, Jesus, the Son of God was sent down by God to build the church, replacing the OT Temple. 967bc appears to be a supported "God Day to God Day" division point.
967bc, would mark the end of God Day 3, the start of God Day 4.
- e) **1967bc has synergy to any number of events surrounding Abraham, Sarah and perhaps Issac that could have occurred at this time.** (*Somewhat speculative because of historical dating variability*) Such events could be: Abraham's birth, getting married, being called by God to the promised land, God making the Covenant with Abraham, being visited by the angel, giving birth to Issac and offering Isaac up to name a few. Abraham is in every respect, the launch pin for God's relationship with the Hebrew people and mankind, but the historical dating mishmash makes it impossible to nail down any specific event tied to Abraham.
1967bc, would mark the end of God Day 2, the start of God Day 3.

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- f) **2967bc has potential synergy to Noah and the Ark** (*highly speculative*) could be within a period that could embrace 2967bc as the start of the 2nd day. Several online sources of Biblical history suggest apx 3000bc. 2967bc would mark the end of God Day 1, the start of God Day 2.

- g) **3967bc potential synergy to Adam and Eve.** (*highly speculative*) 3967bc would mark the start of day 1 using a young earth model.
- h) **Unique Synergy with 120 and 40 “Jubilee” periods and the purpose of the Jubilee.** (*For clarity, it is **NOT** the Jubilee created by the Catholic Church*) God created the day, then He created the week in Genesis and God also created the Jubilee in **Leviticus 25:10-54.**

A Jubilee occurs once every 50 years and it is a yearlong celebration. The Jubilee follows 7, 7-year cycles (49 years). (*The original OT practice of the Hebrew Jubilee, disappeared long ago, today it is only remembered and not practiced. Some rabbis believe the Jubilee year was the 49th year, most believe it was 50th year, as the Leviticus text (Lev 25:10) says to “consecrate the 50th year”*) The 50th year carries several very important characteristics: **a)** a precursor to sound the rams horn throughout the land, **b)** it is a recognition of obedience to God and that everything ultimately is God’s and provided by God, **c)** no agricultural work on the land is done for the year, **d)** the land and followers of God are to “rest”, **e)** all debts are forgiven, **f)** people who are slaves are redeemed (*freed*) and return back to their property or get their property returned back to them.

The overall synergy of the OT Jubilee celebration, its focus on the creator, rest, redemption and freedom should not be lost to Biblical Believer’s with regards to Christ’s return and what we will experience. Our debt is paid, we are free and we enter the 7th God Day, a 1,000 years long period of rest.

Thus, the Jubilee, is another measure of time implemented by God. Because this measure of time carries so much significance, I wanted to see if Jubilees might fit into this 7-God Days model.

- **With regards to 6,000 years of work and toil**, the *6-God Days* period just before the Sabbath Day (7th God Day) let’s do some math: $6000 / 50$ (Jubilee) = 120 Jubilees occurring within the 6000 years of an “age.”

Biblically, the value “**120**” **represents completion or conclusion.** Thus, the end of this 6,000 years we are in, is a “completed work”, it’s the “conclusion of our toil.” Here are some scriptures where 120 is used. **Gen 6:3** Then the Lord said, “My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, because he also is flesh; nevertheless, **his**

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days shall be one hundred and twenty years.” Duet 34:7

Although Moses **was one hundred and twenty years old when he died**, his eye was not dim, nor his vigor abated. **2 Chon 5:12** and all the Levitical singers, Asaph, Heman, Jeduthun and their sons and kinsmen, clothed in fine linen, with cymbals, harps and lyres, standing east of the altar and **with them one hundred and twenty priests blowing trumpets** {Right after the 120 trumpets blew, *God’s Glory filled the Temple. Jesus will likewise soon return to earth and the earth will be filled with His presence*}

In essence: After 120 Jubilee periods, mankind’s striving upon the earth, will have reached its conclusion, our toiling will be completed.

- **With regards to the 2,000 years or 2 God Days since Jesus’s resurrection (33ad) and His return to earth (2033ad). 2000 divided by 50 = 40 Jubilees which would be the period between 33ad and 2033ad;”**

Biblically, the value “40” **represents a period of testing, preparation, cleansing, trial, maybe even punishment.** It can be 40; days, months, years or in this case 40 Jubilees. 40 periods of *testing* that precedes an activity or event that follows it. Here are some scriptures where 40 is used. It rained 40 days while Noah was in the ark, **Gen 7:12** **The rain fell upon the earth for forty days and forty nights**, Jesus was 40 days in the wilderness **Mark 1:13** **And He {Jesus} was in the wilderness forty days being tempted by Satan; and He was with the wild beasts and the angels were ministering to Him**, the Hebrews wandered 40 years in the wilderness, **Num 32:13** **“So the Lord’s anger burned against Israel and He made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until the entire generation of those who had done evil in the sight of the Lord was destroyed, etc..** But the most interesting comparison I draw from the use of 40, is with regard to Nineveh (*which was a very wicked city*) who was given 40 days to repent. **Jonah 3:4** **Then Jonah began to go through the city one day’s walk; and he cried out and said, “Yet forty days and Nineveh will be overthrown.”**

The world as a whole, is like Nineveh, with most of the world living; selfishly, pridefully and absorbed in carnal behavior. Repentance was; Jonah’s, John the Baptist’s and Jesus’s teaching. A common bible theme; *“repent for Judgement is coming!”*

8. **Consider this** – Now mankind is faced with a grave new reality ... we are quickly running up to the end of the 6th God Day (4,000 yrs of bc history + 2,000 yrs of ad history= 6,000 yrs). In my estimation, at best there is <12 of our Gregorian calendar years (*but potentially as few as 5 years*) before the End Time prophecies and Jesus's 2nd coming are all fulfilled. Martyred Believers and those who refused to take the mark of the beast, will then enter the 1,000-year long Sabbath day of rest with Jesus's reigning as King on earth. The "end" is very near! That means a lot of instability and end times chaos **is about to take place**. Read chapters: **Matt 24, Luke 13, Mark 21**

What I am saying with 75% confidence, is that Jesus will return by the end of 2036, based upon 2033 +3 years and I doubt Christ returns before 2030 based upon 2033 -3 years; thus, I think He returns somewhere between 2030 and 2036 ... with a 25% chance I am altogether wrong.

These 8 points reveal Jesus's very soon return, yet the most exciting aspect of His return is we will finally have a **perfect** ruler, someone whose motives are pure, good and absent any corruption. **And** this constant never ending toil we have lived, ends as we Believers reach the finish line and **enter our Sabbath rest!** **Come Lord Jesus Come!**

Heb 4:9-11 **So there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God.** ¹⁰ For the one who has entered His rest has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His. ¹¹ Therefore **let us be diligent to enter that rest, so that no one will fall,** through *following* the same example of disobedience.

Matt 11:29 "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart and you will find rest for your souls. **Ezek 34:15** "I will feed My flock **and I will lead them to rest,**" declares the Lord God.

Jer 6:16 ... where **the good way is and walk in it; and you will find rest for your souls.**

Please understand, I'm not trying to discern the; day, date or month only the year +/- 3 years for dating uncertainty. Even so, I'm saying; "***I'm not 100% sure!***" Rather, my confidence is 75%, but that leaves 25% none of this will occur when I say it will. I want to share what I've found, so others can explore this, or dismiss it as nonsense.

I do realize, this topic is deeper than many Believer's can understand, because a good portion of those who believe in the One True God,

rarely crack open their Bibles. If that's you, may I challenge you to read thru your entire Bible several times in the next few years? Set aside some dedicated time in the morning or evening. Get a couple of good highlighting pencils (I use "Staedtler, Textsurfer Dry") and highlight scriptures as you desire using different colors. (Do not use markers as they bleed thru) I use yellow for Salvation, red for really important things, orange for prophecy and green for general stuff. I've also used a new bible and highlighted the left edges of verses the blue to denote all the words of God spoken by the OT prophets and Jesus in the NT. I do not use a "red letter" words of Jesus Bible version, but they are nice!

Interjection: Depending upon your perspective there are 3 and now perhaps 4 theories for creation origins: **1) Evolutionary model** i.e., absent a creator or god, but still requiring much faith that billions of years ago gases appeared out of absolutely nothing and then energy also magically appeared to blow it up, which created matter from the massive explosion that normally kills life, to develop life. This theory that is taught in our schools is labeled, "the Big Bang". **2) "Old earth" Biblical creation model.** Agrees with the Biblical account, but the lack of other unwritten Biblical creation details and our current knowledge in archeology, support the earth being very old, many, many times older than 6,000 yrs. The old earth model is not troubled by embracing science with the Biblical Creation account. **3) "Young earth" Biblical Creation model.** This group believes that God performed his work in 6, 24-hour days, rested on the 7th day and mankind has been here for roughly 6-10,000 yrs. There are those who adhere to something longer than 6,000 years, but still a young earth. God created Adam as an already aged young man, Eve too. Thus, God is certainly capable of creating an already aged earth. **4) A possible(?) "God Day" Biblical Creation model.** A repeating pattern of ages consisting of 7,000 yrs (an "age") broken into 7 separate 1000 yearlong God Days that goes backward and will proceed forward in time. The Biblical account of creation, is accurate, but we agree that "the Creation account is not a fully detailed description, rather a summary description". The complexity of creating a car or building a home can be told in several ways, from very brief (several paragraphs) to a full room of very detailed manuals regarding each step of the process. So too, with the Biblical Creation model text. God simply gave us a brief summary of what He did and it is an accurate summary. The same is true with historical accounts within the Bible.

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Some accounts have detail, but most are brief summaries that leave out the entirety of what took place. **We don't know, what we don't know.**

Wrap-up

I believe the combined application of; a Biblically defined “God Day”, “7-God Day long age”, a “33 ad” God Day division point and +/-3 years of historical dating uncertainty, reveals a 7 year period of time between early 2030 and the end of 2036 where Jesus is likely (75% probability) to return. This means a lot of Biblical end time prophecy is about to take place. That means Israel becomes a heavy stone (viewed as very burdensome) for the world and worldwide instability unlike anything seen before. **Zech 12:1-3**

The graphic: (the RED cell) 2033 is the likely year of Jesus's return using 33ad is the generally accepted date for Jesus's death/resurrection, plus 2 full "God Days" would add 2,000 yrs to 33ad. **HOWEVER**, the ambiguity related to the actual historical date of Jesus death/resurrection requires +/- 3 yrs of uncertainty to be included which provides about 75% certainty in my mind. Note: 2000 divided by 50 (Jubilees) results in 40. The number 40 is often used in the Bible as a period of testing, preparation, cleansing, trial and/or a transformation from one major action to another. Nineveh was given 40 days to repent and cleanse itself, the people of the earth appear to have been given 40 Jubilee periods (33ad to 20233ad) to do the same, for God's Judgement is coming!

We know that 2 major events have to occur prior to his return.

1) The "prince" will arrange a 7-yr an agreement or treaty between Israel and one or more other entities. (religions, nations, etc)
 2) A war (?) beforehand would be an obvious purpose for an arrangement. Some troubling need has to arise that would warrant an initial 7-year arrangement. However, this agreement will be broken 3.5 yrs into it.

NOTE: Greater and greater worldwide instability has to occur before the antichrist can assume control, expect it!

The 1st and 3rd ★ symbol represents bookends for the possible period of Jesus's return. The center ★ represents the exact year absent +/- 3 yrs of dating uncertainty.

Nothing in this review attempts to pinpoint the actual month, day or hour within any year and I do not care to try to come up with it. Jesus said no man will know the hour or the day of His return. **Matt 24:36-37** “But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone. “For the coming of the Son of Man will be just like the days of Noah.

Some authors and false religious leaders have tried to assign a date for Jesus’ return, but Jesus Himself plainly said, “no one knows.” But Christ admonishes us to understand the “season” we are in. Mark 13:28-31 “From the fig tree learn its lesson: as soon as its branch becomes tender and puts out its leaves, you know that summer is near. So also, **when you see these things taking place,** {described in **Mark 13:3-37**} **you know that He is near, at the very gates.** Truly, I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

Matt 16:1-4 And the Pharisees and Sadducees came and to test him they asked him to show them a sign from heaven. He answered them, “When it is evening, you say, ‘It will be fair weather, for the sky is red.’ And in the morning, ‘It will be stormy today, for the sky is red and threatening.’ You know how to interpret the appearance of the sky, **but you cannot interpret the signs of the times.** An evil and adulterous generation seeks for a sign, but no sign will be given to it except the sign of Jonah.” So, He left them and departed.

Jesus chastises the religious leaders that they can interpret the coming of bad weather, but they could not see and understand the prophetic signs God was fulfilling right before their eyes! **We are also now about to witness prophetic signs being fulfilled in the next few years.** God will not reveal the hour or 24hr day, just the season.

This booklet series is literally seeking to share with you, various aspects regarding the signs of the times, to make you aware, there is

very little time left. Regardless of what happens, come to Jesus, repent and invite Jesus to rule in your heart then you will indeed survive to live again rather than experience an eternal death.

“The Messiah’s Return Series” (TMRS, *estimated to be 12 booklets*) will explore *“soon to be filled Biblical prophecies”* that will take place before the Great Judgement. Our hope must not be in this world or this life, our hope must be grounded in God and His Son, Jesus Christ. We are in the final few years before this all wraps up; many things will be rapidly taking place. Instability will be everywhere throughout the world; there will be very little we can count on. The nations of the world will put the antichrist, an evil leader into power, but before that happens, a majority of people will desire a *“worldwide problem solver”*. To get to that point, the implication is that there will be much instability. But just like God foretold the coming of Jesus Christ His Son, **God has also revealed what will be going down in the end time.** God has proven that He not only knows the future but God insures it goes down just as He says it will. God wants us to know; **you can trust Him.**

Amos 3:7 Surely the Lord GOD does nothing unless He reveals His secret counsel to His servants the prophets. **Jer 1:12** Then the Lord said to me, “You have seen well, for I am watching over My word to perform it.” **John 16:12-15** “I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. ¹³When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all the truth, for He will not speak on his own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak and He will declare to you the things that are to come. ¹⁴He will glorify me, for He will take what is mine and declare it to you. ¹⁵All that the Father has is mine; therefore, I said that He will take what is mine and declare it to you.

2 Peter 3:1-2 This is now the second letter that I am writing to you, beloved. In both of them I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of reminder, ²that you should remember the predictions of the holy prophets and the commandment of the Lord and Savior through your apostles,

Acts 3:19-24 Repent therefore and turn back, {to God} that your sins may be blotted out, ²⁰that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord and that He may send the Christ appointed for you, Jesus, ²¹whom heaven must receive until the time for restoring all the things about which God spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets long ago. ²²Moses said, ‘The Lord God will raise up for you a prophet like me from your brothers. You shall listen to him in whatever He tells

you. ²³ And it shall be that every soul who does not listen to that prophet shall be destroyed from the people.’ ²⁴ **And all the prophets who have spoken, from Samuel and those who came after him, also proclaimed these days.**

Isaiah 46:9-10 ... “Remember the former things long past, for I am God, and there is no other; *I am* God, and there is no one like Me, ¹⁰ **Declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things which have not been done,** saying, ‘**My purpose will be established** and I will accomplish all My good pleasure’;

Jude 17-18 But you, beloved, ought to remember the words that were spoken beforehand by the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁸ that they were saying to you, “**In the last time there will be mockers, following after their own ungodly lusts.**” Wow, this verse certainly rings true today!

Why does ... why is ... God waiting so long? 2 Peter 3:9 **The Lord is not slow about His promise, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.** God knows the right time to gather the wheat in to His storehouse. God will harvest the souls that are devoted to Him at the peak and best time. Everyone who wants to come to God, God gives the opportunity. But there will soon be a day where no one else desires to come to the Lord. Then He will separate the weeds from the wheat and cast the weeds into the fire. We have been ordered to invite everyone we can. **Matt 22:8-10** **Then he said to his servants, ‘The wedding feast is ready, but those invited were not worthy. ⁹ Go therefore to the main roads and invite to the wedding feast as many as you find.’** ¹⁰ And those servants {you and I} went out into the roads and gathered all whom they found, both bad and good. So, the wedding hall was filled with guests. Let’s invite everyone, give them a Bible, hand out tracts, love on our neighbors and strangers alike, until the hallways leading to the wedding feast are filled!

Awareness of God and our condition before Him

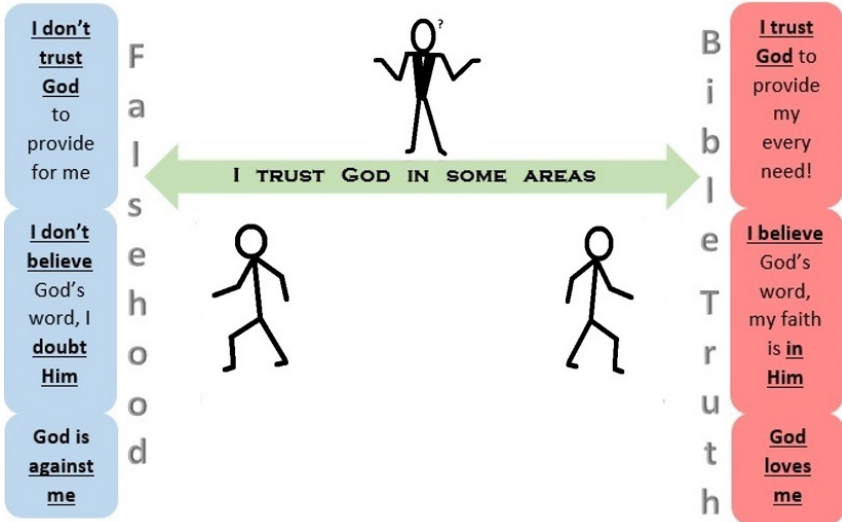
- ✓ An awareness that there has to be a God, otherwise our life has no purpose and little in this life journey makes any sense.

Others like myself, needed all the info we could get, we had to make a rational determination in our head before the one with our heart.

As Christian's we have to not only believe "in" God, we have to "trust" God



You and I are not an accident in an evolutionary chain of events, humans were created by and in the image of the One True God.

Gen 1:27 God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. God loves you and I and He seeks a relationship with us, based in truth and love. God is a loving Father to those who submit to Him, but He will be an angry God to those who reject His Son and the costly sacrifice Jesus paid.

This is all about to wrap up. It is time we all get serious with God, it is time for you to make a decision. If you've considered God with your head, but never made the 16" move to your heart, now is the time!

You can decide that today is the day, "you" make the choice to surrender **your** life to Jesus Christ. In the privacy of your own home or at your church, you can begin speaking to God, He will hear you ...

- I shall call out to God and **confess** my sins to God,
- I shall **repent** of those sins, asking God to help me overcome them,

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- I shall **believe in my heart** and fully trust that Jesus died for my sins and substitutionally paid my sin debt,
- I shall **get baptized** (*being immersed under the water*) to signify the death of my old self and being raised anew, (*born again*)
- I shall **welcome** the Holy Spirit into my heart, asking God to fill me with His Spirit and to be Lord of my life.
- I shall begin **praying**, spending purposeful time talking to God, thanking God, worshipping God, bringing my and the needs of others to Him.
- I shall begin daily **reading the Bible and meeting with other believers** to grow in my faith, devotion and spiritual maturity.

Below are some of the Scriptures outlining Biblical Salvation. Keep in mind that being “Born Again” and getting “Saved” should and will result in a changed heart and life. In essence, when we come to God, we are saying, *“God help me, I need and want you to help me be the best I can be. I’m ashamed of how I’ve lived my life, please take over and guide me, make me pleasing in Your sight.”* Nobody who is Born Again, can remain the same, the Holy Spirit will begin changing you ... unless you rebelliously decide to cling to fleshly and worldly behaviors. God can cleanse you if you ask from a sincere heart. Some people have said all the weight, guilt and shame of their sins fell away immediately, for others like me, it took time.

REPENT - Matt 4:17 *From that time **Jesus began to preach and say, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”*** Mark 1:4 *John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness **preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.*** Luke 13:5 *“I tell you, no, but **unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.**”* Luke 15:7 *“I tell you that in the same way, **there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents** than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.* Acts 3:19-20 *“**Therefore repent and return, so that your sins may be wiped away,** in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord;²⁰ and that He may send Jesus, **the Christ appointed for you,***

BELIEVE - John 3:14-18 *“As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man {Jesus Christ} be lifted up {esteemed as Savior};¹⁵ so that **whoever believes will in Him have eternal life.**¹⁶ **“For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have***

eternal life. ¹⁷ “For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, **but that the world might be saved through Him.** ¹⁸ **Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.** John 11:25-27 Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life; **he who believes in Me will live even if he dies,** ²⁶ and **everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?”** ²⁷ She said to Him, “**Yes, Lord; I have believed that You are the Christ, the Son of God, even He who comes into the world.**” Acts 16:30-34 and after he brought them out, he said, “Sirs, **what must I do to be saved?”** ³¹ They said, “**Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved,** you and your household.” ³² And they **spoke the word of the Lord to him** together with all who were in his house. ³³ And he took them that *very* hour of the night and washed their wounds and **immediately he was baptized,** he and all his *household*. ³⁴ And he brought them into his house and set food before them and rejoiced greatly, **having believed in God** with his whole household.

INVITE - Acts 2:21 ‘**And it shall be that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.**’ Rom 10:13 **For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”** Acts 2:37-41 **Now when they heard *this*, they were pierced to the heart and** said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “**Brethren, what shall we do?”** ³⁸ Peter *said* to them, “**Repent and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** ³⁹ “**For the promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off, {distant future, future generations} as many as the Lord our God will call to Himself.”** ⁴⁰ And with many other words he solemnly testified and kept on exhorting them, saying, “**Be saved from this perverse generation!**” ⁴¹ So then, those **who had received his word** were baptized; and that day there were added *{to the kingdom of God}* about three thousand souls.

IT’S FAITH - NOT WORKS - Eph 2:8-9 **For *by grace* {unmerited favor} you have been saved through faith;** and that *not of yourselves, {you cannot be good enough} it is the gift* {Jesus Christ dying for our sins} of God; ⁹ **not as a result of works,** so that no one may boast. Titus 3:5-7 He saved us, **not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness,** but **according to His mercy,** by **the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,** ⁶ whom He poured out

upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, ⁷ so that being justified by His grace we would be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. **Rom 9:30-32** What shall we say, then? That Gentiles {non Hebrew} who did not pursue righteousness have attained it, that is, a righteousness that is by faith; ³¹ but that Israel who pursued a law that would lead to righteousness did not succeed in reaching that law. ³² Why? Because they did not pursue it by faith, but as if it were based on works. **Rom 10:1-4** Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved. ² For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. ³ For, being ignorant of the righteousness of God and seeking to establish their own {righteousness}, they did not submit to God's righteousness. ⁴ For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

DIE TO SELF, LIVE FOR CHRIST **John 3:7** “Do not be amazed that I said to you, ‘You must be born again.’ **Rom 10:9-11** because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart one believes and is justified and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. ¹¹ For the Scripture says, “Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame.”

Jesus is Coming Back Very Soon!

Narrative of My “God Day” Journey:

I'm not the guy who sprinkles my conversation with “*God spoke to me*”, because I just don't really know if God did speak in front of me, that I would still be standing. I can explain it no other way than it must have been the Holy Spirit that revealed to me what a “God Day” is. I'm often at odds with myself, *is this the voice of my conscience or God?* There was no doubt when God spoke to the OT prophets, they knew without a doubt, it was God speaking.

God's Word (*Bible*) certainly speaks to me and I love reading the Word of God, yet I have a misfit memory and have much trouble with remembering names (*dyslexia?*). I have to read the Bible over and over to get it to sink in. “*I m n unejukat'd slowe lerner*”. Early in 2023, in the early morning hours I was reading scripture. I was reading in Genesis, chapters 1 thru 6. Reading the Bible is always new, I learn new stuff all the time. But this time, I was faced with a Biblical quandary ... I read in **Gen 2:16-17** And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, “You may

surely eat of every tree of the garden, ¹⁷ but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.” However, a little while later I then read in chapter 5 that Adam lived to be 930 years old. **Gen 5:5: Thus, all the days that Adam lived were 930 years and he died.**

So, I was faced with a dilemma; did God lie by not killing Adam in the day he ate of the fruit? Or was I missing something that makes what I read true? Perhaps if you are a reader of the Word, you too maybe thought of it as a euphemism of sorts, a veiled threat if you will that Adam would die on the day he ate of the tree.

But, as always, God can not lie (**Titus 1:2**), so I knew I had to be missing something, because in **every situation, God’s truth stands.** As I pondered this, I was reminded of a verse somewhere in the NT about a 1,000 years being “just as day to God”, after jumping into my “[Logos Bible Study](#)” software program, I reread **2 Peter 3:8** **But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years and a thousand years as one day.** Interestingly, Peter uses this same chapter 3 to discuss aspects of the coming return of Jesus Christ, a prophetic future event and certainly a climax event in this booklet series I’m writing. Peter was giving us a framework to understand the end times, the times we are in right now. This aspect of God is confirmed a 3rd time. **Psalm 90:4** **For a thousand years in your sight are but as yesterday when it is past, or as a watch in the night.**

OK, we are being instructed how God views a day, as 1,000 years, Adam died at age 930 yrs old, **so Adam did in fact die in the day he ate of the tree!** A 1,000 yearlong God Day. **WOW,** now what do I do with this?

My curiosity was watered; I began searching for the words “a day” and “one day” in my [Logos Bible Study program](#). I was drawn to **Gen 1:5, 8, 13, 19, 23, 31** that I had just read. Each day of creation was part of a week, a week that culminated in the with 7th day, a day that God rested. **Gen 2:2** **By the seventh day God completed His work which He had done and He rested on the seventh day** from all His work which He had done. We call this 7th day, the Sabbath day. **Heb 4:9-10** **So there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God.**¹⁰ For the one who has entered His rest has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His. A study of the Sabbath day of rest is clearly warranted, for it is something God not only did Himself, but also commanded us to do. We work for 6-days, we rest on the 7th. **Ex 16:29-30** **“See, the Lord has**

given you the sabbath; therefore, He gives you bread for two days on the sixth day. Remain every man in his place; let no man go out of his place on the seventh day.”³⁰ So the people rested on the seventh day.

Somewhere in the back of my memory (*or the Holy Spirit's leading*) I recalled in the book of Revelation, a period of time where Satan will be locked up for 1,000 years, which is often referred to as the “millennium”. **Revelation chapter 19:** finishes with Jesus conquering all the enemies of His people, casting the beast and the false prophet into the Lake of Fire. In **Revelation chapter 20:**, we learn Satan is bound into the bottomless pit (abyss) for a 1,000 years and the martyred Saints of God and those who did not take the mark of the Beast are resurrected and reign with Christ during that 1,000 year long period. Then Satan is released after the 1,000 year day of rest (Sabbath) is completed.

God is God after all, if He rests on the 7th day of every week and wants us to rest as well, including Satan, then God makes it happen!

Thus, I believe this 1,000 years long God Day period that Satan is locked up for, is the end of the week. Yet, I understand most of us view the Sabbath of day of rest as a Sunday and thus the start of a new week, because of the way our modern Gregorian calendar is laid out. Explaining that topic is a can of worms, I will not dive into.

It became clear to me ... Satan is locked up for 1,000 years because; God and mankind will be enjoying the Sabbath rest. The Sabbath rest is the bookend to the prior 6-days of the history in this our current “age.”

4,000 years of what we describe as bc, (*Before Christ*) followed by 2,000 years of what is labeled ad, the combination of 6-1,000 yearlong God Days and the 1,000 year long millennium (Sabbath) God Day, equals an “age”, i.e. 7,000 years total or one “age”.

I believe Jesus will return again sometime between the start of 2030 ... and the end of 2036 (*most likely based upon the Hebrew calendar*) **and this time as conquering King!** The final few years of life as we know it is about to come to an end; there will be increasing instability as we move forward to its end. Think about this, **it is literally about to happen!**

The only preparation you or I need is to get in right relationship with God, we do that by repenting of our sins, confessing our sins to God, to believe and trust God and His Son to do what they said they will do, “**to save us**”. **1 John 5:11-12** And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life and this life is in His Son.¹² He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life.
